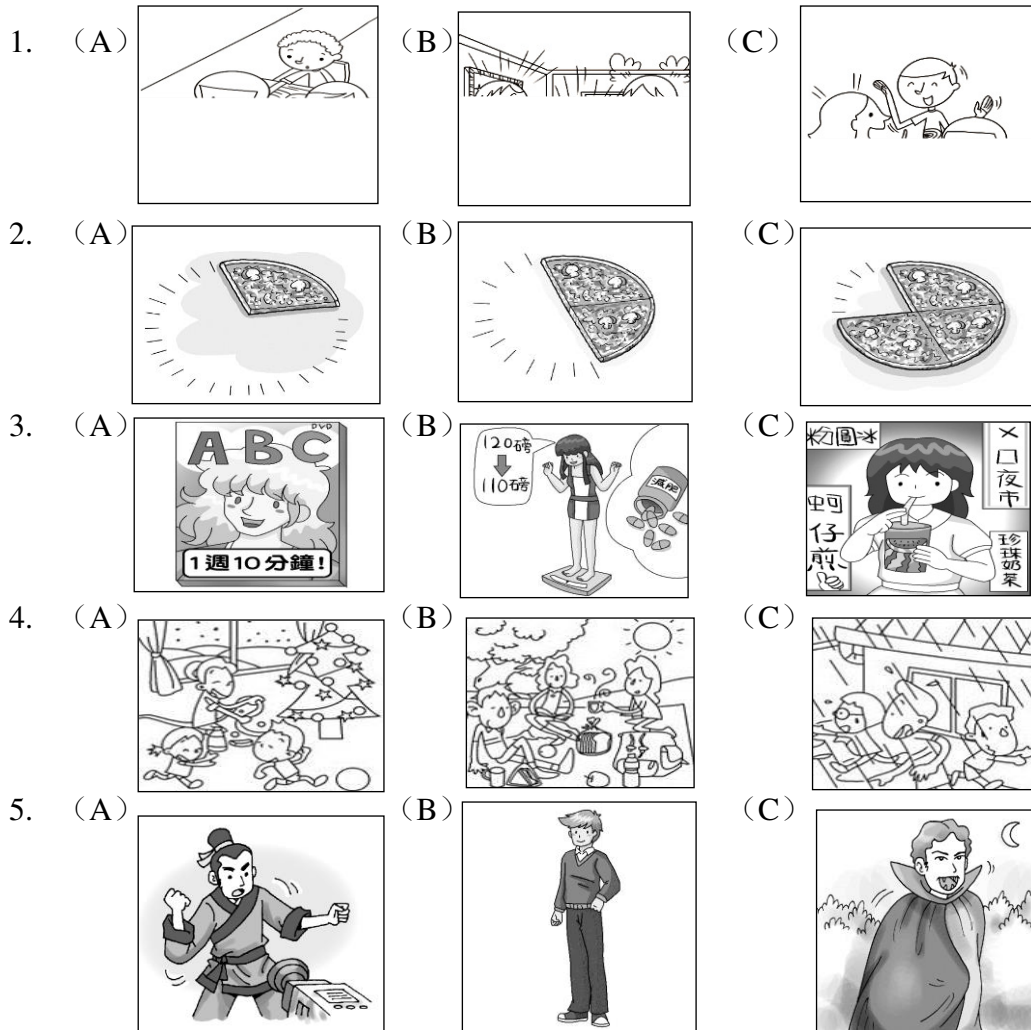

In many countries, there are no 5G mobile networks. However, COVID-19 is still spreading. So, 5G mobile networks are not the reason why people get sick.



Do only older people get COVID-19?
